

The Director of Emergency Services, San Joaquin County Supervisor Dario Marengo hereby issues the following order pursuant to Government Code §8634:

- 1) The Director of Emergency Services has determined from his evaluation of all information gathered from those involved in the active flood fight, including but not limited to criteria determined by state, local or federal agencies, that it is necessary to act. Disaster Service Workers as necessary to fight developing or imminent flooding shall be granted access to, in a reasonable manner, all private and/or public levees or property on, near or adjacent to the San Joaquin River and the Stanislaus River between the Stanislaus County and San Joaquin County line at Interstate 5, north to Hiway 205, east to Hiway 99, south to the Stanislaus County line, and southwest along the Stanislaus River.
- 2) Upon access to said described lands, assigned Disaster Service Workers designated by the Incident Commander(s), as necessary to fight the active flood, are granted authority to take all reasonable and necessary preventative measures and/or emergency repairs of the levees.
- 3) This order shall take effect immediately and remain in effect until terminated by the Director of Emergency Services.
