Thornton Rd. closed at Sacramento County line

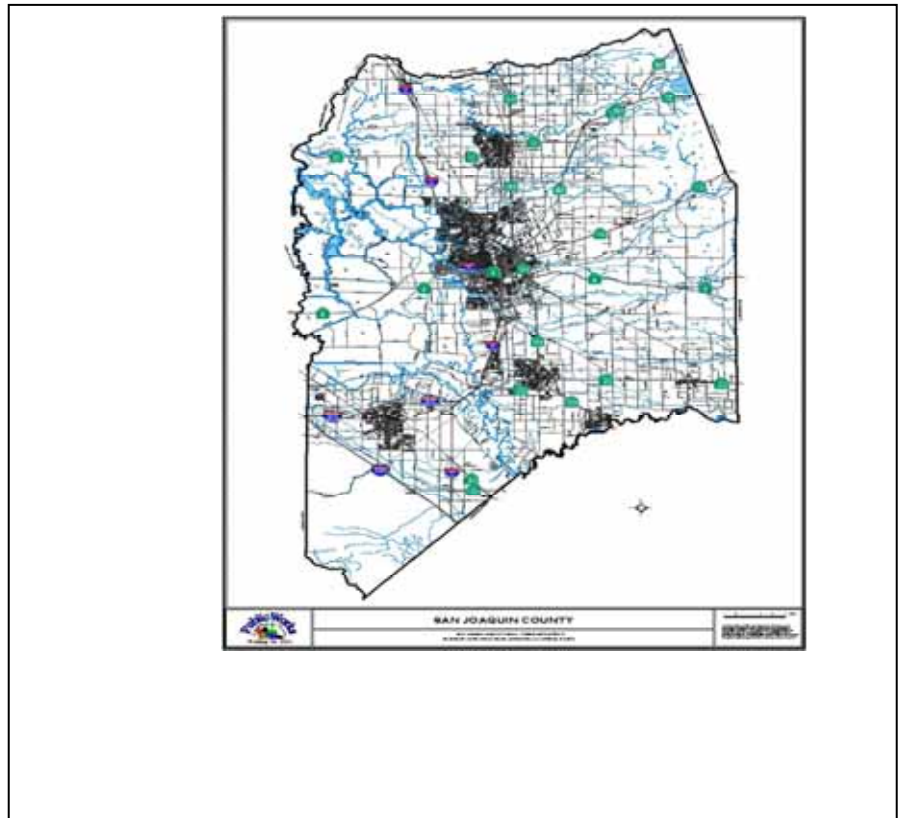
North Cherokee Lane closed between Liberty Rd and Collier Rd.
