**P**rotect yourself and your family from mosquito bites that can spread West Nile Virus:

- ▶ All it takes is one bite from an infected mosquito to get West Nile Virus. Anyone can get sick.
- ▶ Use mosquito repellent containing DEET or Picaridin when outdoors. Peak biting times are at dusk and dawn.
- ▶ Drain standing water around your property. Don't give mosquitoes a place to develop.
- ▶ You can help fight West Nile Virus!
